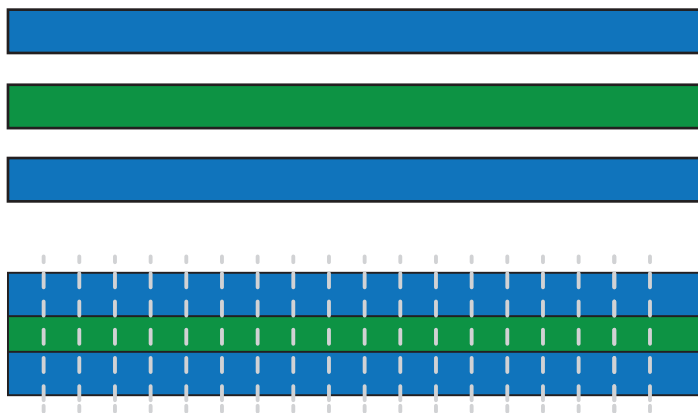


**BLOCK COMPONENT 1****Component Size:** 6½" x 30½" (16.5 cm x 77.5 cm)**Notes:** Yardage and cuts are based on fabric that is at least 42" (106.7 cm) wide. Seam allowances are ¼" (6 mm). Strips are cut across the width of fabric. Press all seams open.**CUTTING THE FABRIC STRIPS****For the six components needed for the entire quilt:**

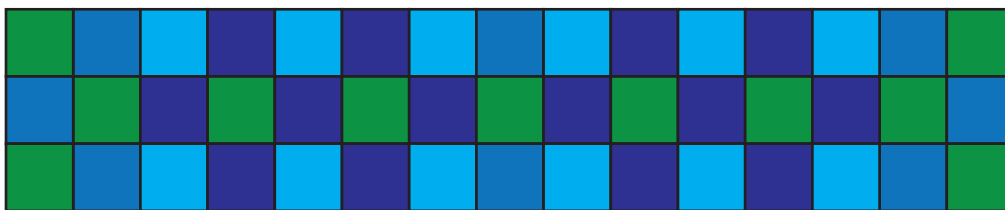
- From blue damask batik (#6072 Whirlpool), cut five 2½" (6.4 cm) A strips.
- From blue ring dot batik (#6073 Whirlpool), cut six 2½" (6.4 cm) B strips.
- From blue marble fabric (Krystal #1265), cut seven 2½" (6.4 cm) C strips.
- From green floral batik (#6081 Caribbean), cut two 2½" (6.4 cm) D strips.
- From green clown check batik (#6074 Caribbean), cut four 2½" (6.4 cm) E strips.

*You may choose to cut the strips into 20" (50.8 cm) lengths to reduce the risk of distortion.***CONSTRUCTING THE STRATA**

1. Refer to the diagram and sew three strips together to make 24 strip sets. Sew the middle strip to the left, then right.
 - Strata A: Strips A, E, A. Make 2.
 - Strata B: Strips B, C, B. Make 3.
 - Strata C: Strips C, D, C. Make 2.
 - Strata D: Strips E, A, E. Make 1.
2. Subcut each strata into 2½" (6.4 cm) units for a total of 18 from Strata A, 36 from Strata B, 24 from Strata C, and 12 from Strata D (90 units total).

**CONSTRUCTING THE BLOCK COMPONENT**

1. Refer to the diagram to lay out 3 Strata A units, 6 Strata B units, 4 Strata C units, and 2 Strata D units (15 total) for the first block component. Piece together and press seams open.
2. Repeat Step 1 to make a total of 6 block components measuring 6½" x 30½" (16.5 cm x 77.5 cm).



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
