



Scrapbasket Quilt Guild 2017 Mystery Block of the Month

(Size: 48 x 48)

Description:

This year's Block of the Month quilt was designed to help celebrate the 30th anniversary of the Scrapbasket Quilt Guild. It is, therefore, a grouping of 9 different BASKET blocks with an alternate block used to complete the "on point" setting with two borders. Each quilter will be given the opportunity to "change up" his/her block on some months with a choice of adding appliqued flowers. Otherwise, only two of the blocks have handles that need to be applied by your choice of applique technique. January: Fabric Selection for entire quilt

Estimates for this fabric assumes long strips are pieced.

- Baskets (tans or browns??):
 - Dark, ¼ yd.
 - Light, 7/8 yd.
 - Med, 1/8 yd.
- "Flowers" & Borders (your choice of a colorway):
 - Dark, 1 yd.
 - Med, ¼ yd.
 - Light, 7/8 yd.
- Background (your choice):
 - 1 + 5/8 yd.
- Stem & Flower Parts (probably green):
 - 1/8 yd.

Following Schedule: February thru October= basket blocks, November=4 alternate blocks, December=finishing top and quilting.

The Plan: In addition to the joy of just making the quilt, each month you can show your completed block to Ann or Beth to have your name placed in the drawing at the end of the year for a quilting surPRIZE.
