

## Piecing Instructions for “Scrap Basket” Block BOM for June 2017

1. From triangles made from 2 3/8” squares:

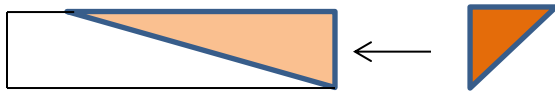
- Using 4 Background and 4 Dark Basket Fabric triangles create four (4) Half Square triangles. Finished each will measure 2” square.
- Using 4 Background and 4 Medium Basket Fabric triangles create four (4) Half Square triangles. Finished each will measure 2” square.

2. From triangles made from 6 7/8” squares:

- Using 1 Background and 1 Medium Basket Fabric triangle create one (1) Half Square triangle. Finished square will measure 6 1/2”.

3. From templates E and H:

- Seam together creating one rectangle, then add a Medium Basket fabric triangle as shown:



4. From templates C and G:

- Seam together, creating one rectangle, then add a Medium Basket fabric triangle as shown:



5. Join one Medium and one Dark half square triangle.



Make 4 of these units.

Join two of the units above so the Medium and Dark HSTs are alternated:



Add the 2” square background piece here.

6. Join two more of the units made in 5 above so that the triangles are angled as follows:



7. Following the picture included in the Cutting Instructions, sew the unit made in 6 above to the 6 1/2” Half Square Triangle. Press to the large HST.

8. Sew the finished unit completed in 5 above to the top of the HST. Now 8 1/4” square.

9. Following the picture from Cutting Instructions, sew the rectangles completed in 3 and 4 above to the remaining sides of the square completed in 8 above.

10. Sew the Background Fabric triangle made from the 3 7/8” to the “base” of the basket to complete the block.
